7:00pm Thomas Fallon called the meeting to order. The Town cable staff was present and the meeting was recorded live. No other attendee was recording the meeting.

7:00pm Applicant: Greenhill Engineering, a Notice of Intent for a septic system repair on property located at 20 Tinker Hill Road, Auburn, MA. Map 65, Parcel 26. The office received a Request to Continue. Carolyn Corriveau motioned to continue the hearing until August 14 @ 7:00pm, second by Nathan Rand. The vote was all in favor.

33 Old Cart Road. A request for a partial release of the Order of Conditions. This order was issued to the Town of Auburn Sewer Dept. for access to sewer lines and any easements. Nathan Rand motioned to issue a Partial Release (Lot 54), second by Carolyn Corriveau. The vote was all in favor. A Certificate of Compliance was signed.

7:05pm Applicant: Michelle Weagle, a Request for Determination for the construction of a deck on property located 73 Shore Dr., Auburn, MA. Map 5, Parcel 12. Carolyn Corriveau motioned to open the public hearing, second by Nathan Rand. The vote was all in favor. Present for the hearing was relative Dan Noyes. Mr. Noyes explained the request for the installation of a deck to obtain a second means of egress from the second floor of the dwelling. The deck will be 24 X 12 running the width of the dwelling and allowing the view of the water. Antonios Romniou motioned to close the public hearing and to issue a Negative Determination, second by Carolyn Corriveau. The vote was all in favor. A DOA was signed.

7:14pm Antonios Romniou motioned to close the meeting, second by Nathan Rand. The vote was all in favor.
